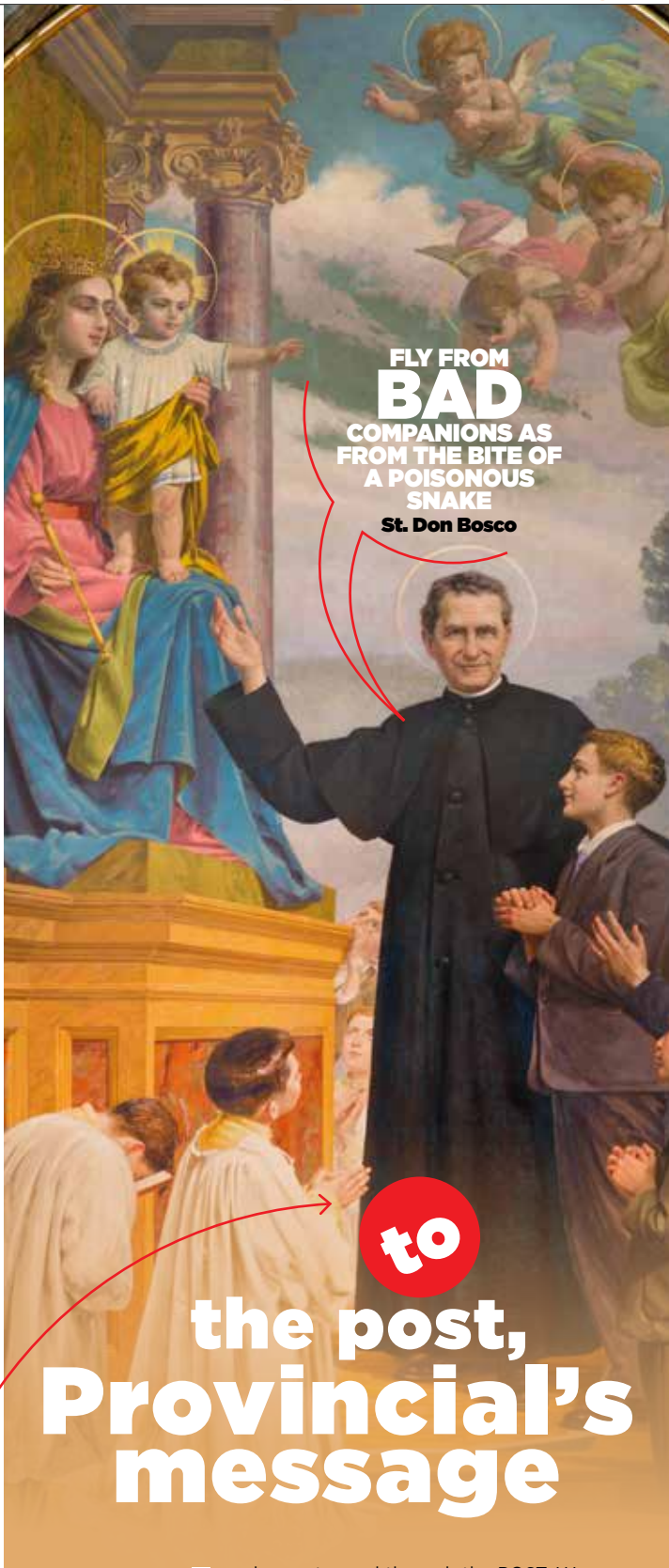

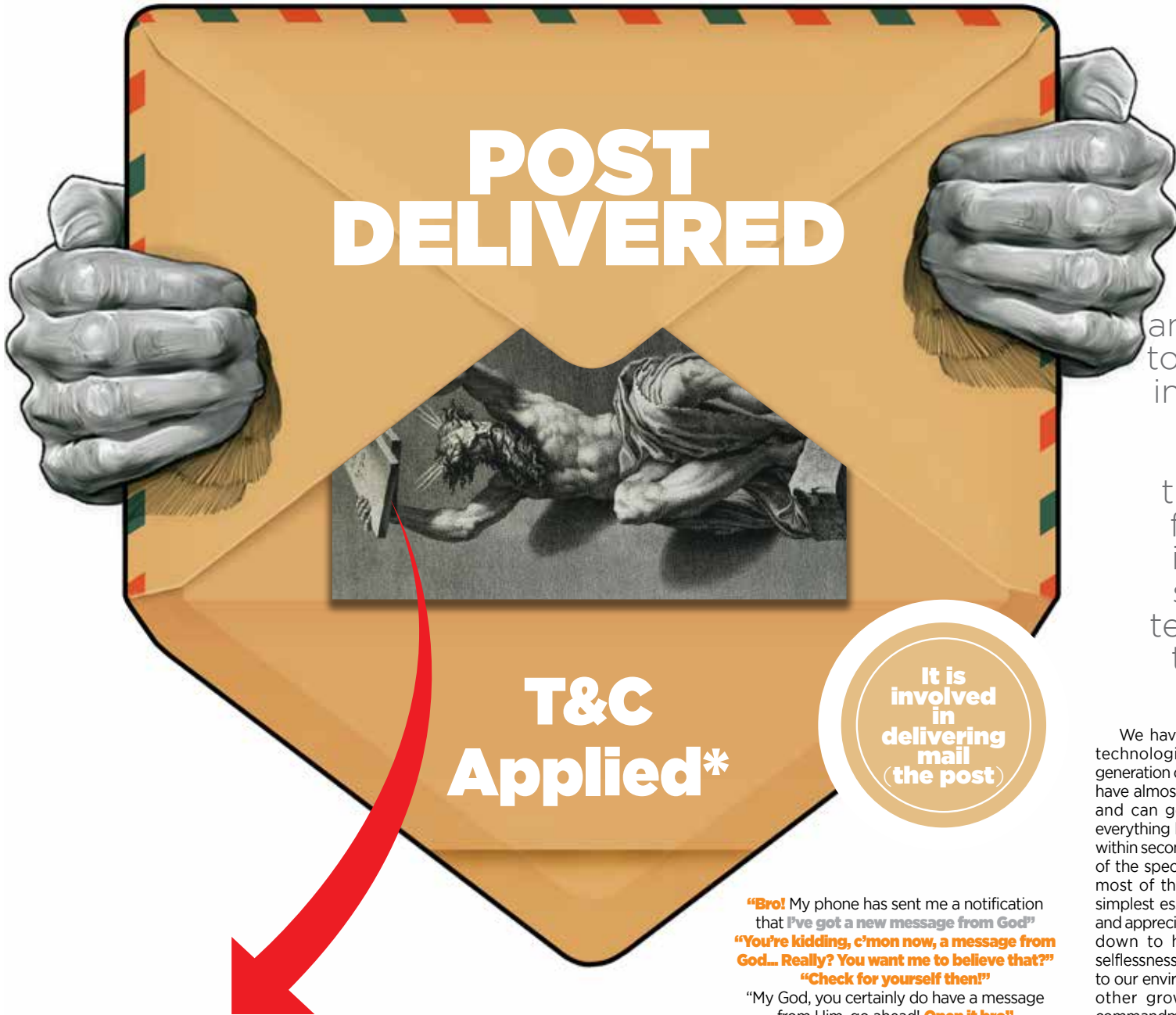
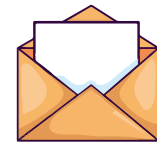

- 10.** You shall not covet.

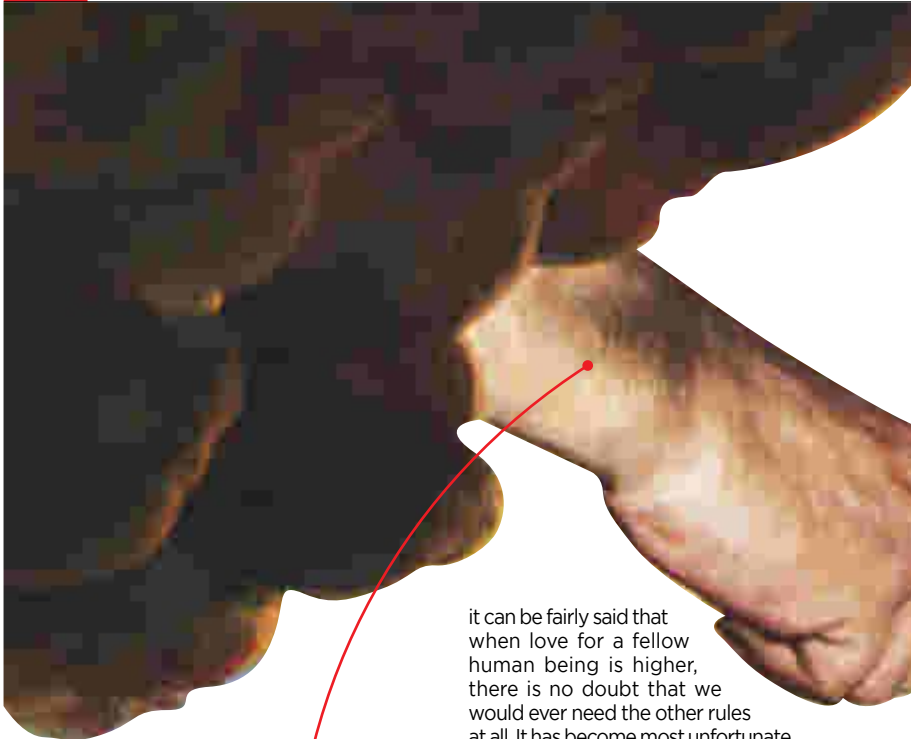
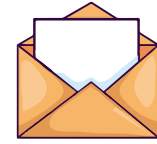
The commandments, simple in language with the complexity of the universe between each word has very clearly advocated for the humanity that the world now deserves.

THE FIRST INDIAN SHIPPING COMPANY IN INDIA AND V.O.CHIDAMBARAM PILLAI

One brave Indian businessman put up a plan to fight the British business people in the passenger shipping. His shipping company was a lifeline of hope for many to come. He is V.O.Chidambaram Pillai

V.O.C. supported movements against the British government and its policies. He openly protested against the British in many cases and was under constant vigilance of the British government.

He was a staunch Swadeshi follower and burnt any foreign goods which he can lay his hands. He floated his Swadeshi Shipping corporation, which ran two ships, shifting people between India and Srilanka. Swadeshi Shipping corporation was the first time that a shipping corporation run by an Indian company to see the port in Tamilnadu after British dominance in India. Swadeshi Shipping corporation was a shareholding company and, thus, a considerable responsibility laid in the hands of V.O.C.

He went to Mumbai and purchased the Ships for the company. The rivals were the British Steam company, of course, run by the British. Many Indians prefer to travel in Swadeshi Shipping Corporation Ship to convey their support on Swadeshi. British Shipping Corporation offered many freebies, but people were not changing their minds. Shifting customers left a considerable mark

in the British businessmen in Tuticorin, who had direct links to the Collector Winch (Collector is like Mayor of the city). And they were all waiting for an opportunity to end Swadeshi shipping corporation and to seal the fate of V.O.C.

V.O.C. developed a good friendship with Subramanian Siva and Subramaniya Bharathi, who got labeled as revolutionaries by the British India government. V.O.C. and Subramani Siva were followers of the Indian National Congress and attended the I.N.C. conference in Varanasi

and Surat. They both developed a unique friendship that lasted for a long time.

They both organized meetings in Tuticorin city to protest against the British, and these meetings were watched keenly by the intelligence department of British India. Luck went in favor of the British when V.O.C. and Siva joined in support of the labor strikes in Coral Mills Tuticorin. He supported the labors so much that he sold his entire asset to help the workers. British warned V.O.C. and Siva to stay away from the strikes, but they didn't oblige. During the negotiations, Ashe was the deputy collector of Tuticorin, gave a final warning to V.O.C.

V.O.C. and Siva decided to celebrate the release of Chandra Powney from jail, A celebrated freedom fighter from West Bengal. Collector Winch didn't grant permission for the celebration. V.O.C. and Siva went on with the ceremony barring the ban. They were both



arrested and produced to the district magistrate. Riots spread across Tuticorin and Tirunelveli the worse seen in decades. British tried with iron hands to bring down the riots. This arrest of V.O.C. and Siva was the ignition point for Vanchinathan and his friends to take up arms to fight against the British. Vanchinathan would later kill Collector Ashe.

V.O.C lived the rest of his in relative peace abstaining from active politics and wrote many books on Tamil literature

For his contributions, the Indian government has named the Thuthukudi port in his name The company he floated Swadeshi Steam Navigation Company got liquidated and the irony is the British Steam company bought the ships.

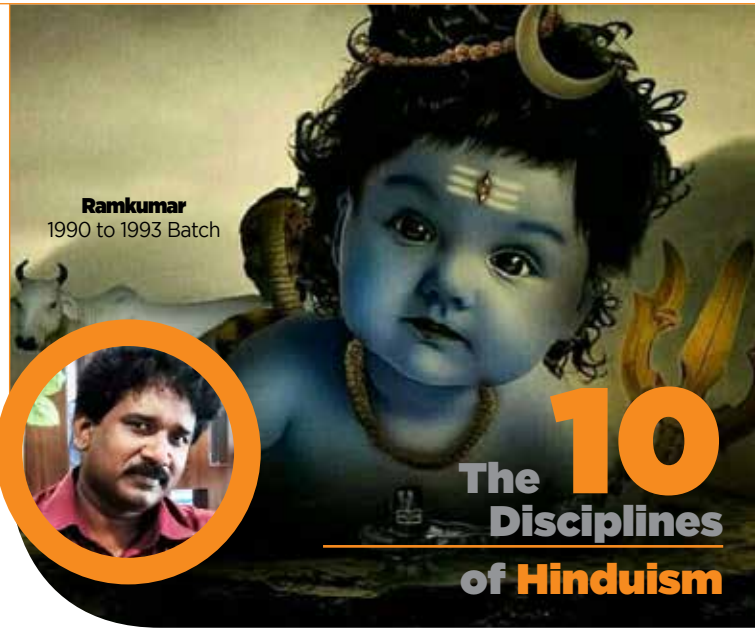
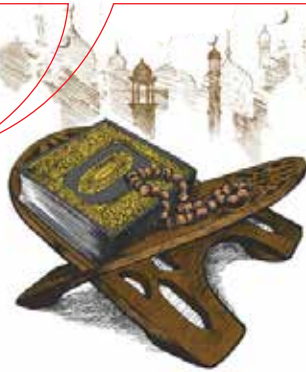

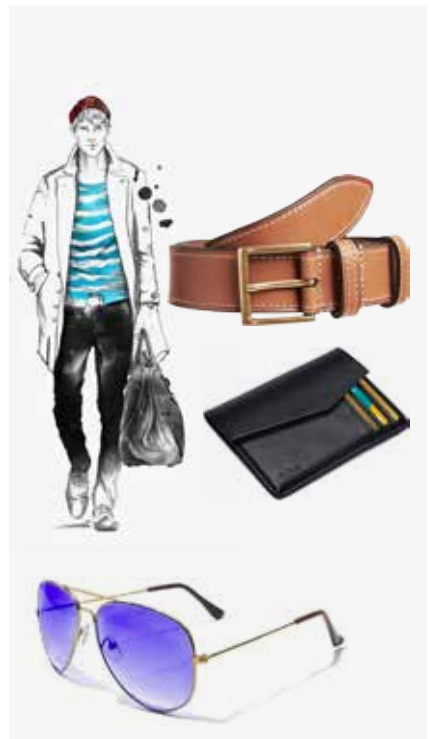

Print on Demand & Self Publishing



other publishers/service providers depending upon varied distribution/geographical location/higher royalty/etc.

No upfront book publishing/printing costs are incurred

Author pays only for the services availed - Cover design, Interior design, Account set-up, Marketing, Bulk copies, etc.

No upfront printing of copies takes place. Self publishing has a unique aspect called Print-on-Demand - the book is printed by the POD printers only when an order is placed on the online distribution channels. Thus, author is not asked to pay fully or partially for bulk printing and stocking of books, as seen in the case of traditional publishing.



Print on demand (POD) is a printing technology and business process in which book copies or other documents are not printed until the company receives an order, allowing prints of single or small quantities. While other industries established the build to order business model, "print on demand" could only develop after the beginning of digital printing, because it was not economical to print single copies using traditional printing technology such as letterpress and offset printing.

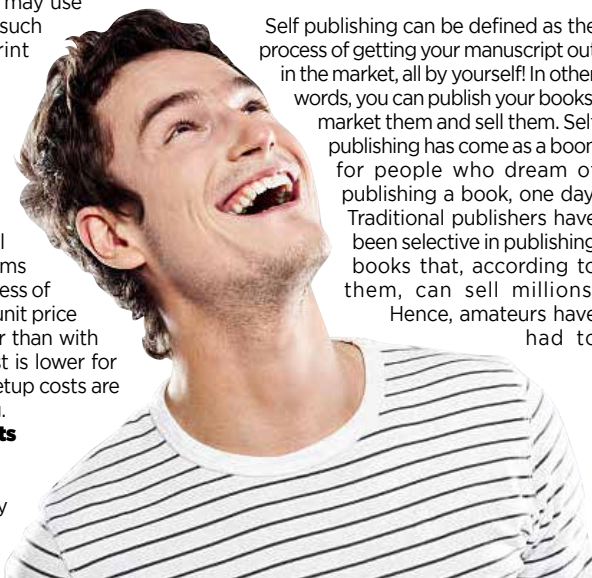
Many traditional small presses have replaced their traditional printing equipment with POD equipment or contract their printing to POD service providers. Many academic publishers, including university presses, use POD services to maintain large backlists (lists of older publications); some use POD for all of their publications. Larger publishers may use POD in special circumstances, such as reprinting older, out-of-print titles, or for test marketing.

Book publishing

Print on demand with digital technology is a way to print items for a fixed cost per copy, regardless of the size of the order. While the unit price of each physical copy is greater than with offset printing, the average cost is lower for very small print jobs, because setup costs are much greater for offset printing.

POD has other business benefits besides lesser costs (for small jobs)

Technical set-up is usually quicker than for offset printing.



Self Publishing

Large inventories of a book or print material do not need to be kept in stock, reducing storage, handling costs, and inventory accounting costs.

There is little or no waste from unsold products.

Many publishers use POD for other printing needs other than books such as galley proof, catalogs and review copies.

These advantages reduce the risks associated with publishing books and prints and can result in increased choice for consumers. However, the reduced risks for the publisher can also mean that quality control is less rigorous than usual.

Self publishing can be defined as the process of getting your manuscript out in the market, all by yourself! In other words, you can publish your books, market them and sell them. Self publishing has come as a boon for people who dream of publishing a book, one day. Traditional publishers have been selective in publishing books that, according to them, can sell millions. Hence, amateurs have had to



confront rejections. Still, people with a fire in them, to write, never ever gave up writing! For a passion, always remains a passion, it never subsides, come what may. Book publishing in India is set to explode with the new model of self-publishing. Self publishing is enabled by print on demand (POD) technology. In print-on-demand (POD) publishing, new copies of a book are printed as and when orders come in.

Self publishing is an alternative and a better publishing option for authors, famous or new. Self publishing has many advantages to offer for writers of all kinds - Better control on the content since author owns the copyright

CAN A PARTIES TO THE MARRIAGE CHANGE RELIGION AFTER THE MARRIAGE?



All the marriages are religious except the civil marriages performed under law or by non-religious group such as atheists or communists.

Hindu religion provides both customary marriage and non-customary marriage. The only requirements under the Hindu marriage is both the parties must be Hindus. If both the parties even atheist or communist prefer to marry themselves under Hindu Marriage Act are governed by the Hindu Law. The Hindu Law gives permission to divorce other person whom their spouse converts themselves to other religions or renounces the world by obtaining sanyasa. If a person is Hindu at the time of Marriage converts himself or herself to Christianity or Islam or any other religion the other person to the Hindu Marriage may approach the court for divorce on the conversion ground. Mere attending the church mass or going to dargha and having prayers of other religion is not a ground but conversion is need for the valid cut off for the divorce.

The Religions such as Buddhists, Jain and Sikh were covered under Hindu Marriage Act. But there was no law settled or the courts declared that conversion from Hinduism to Buddhist or a Jain or a Sikh was granted divorce on the basis of religious conversion. But it is of an opinion that even a Hindu Who converts to Buddhist or a Jain or Sikh can be granted divorce for conversion even they all and one governed by the same law which is the Hindu Marriage Act.

In India there are lakhs of persons are converting themselves from Hinduism to Buddhism. And in significant manner to Christianity and Islam. But becoming a communist or atheist after the Hindu marriage is not a ground for divorce. The Hindu law made a big hole in its traditional and customary law and even the modern progressive Hindu law

also has not included of becoming communist or atheist after marriage is a ground for divorce which defeats the very purpose of the Hindu marriage. But it is a sad news that even the communist and atheist born to the Hindu fathers are governed under Hindu Law. There was no law governing the marriage between the non-religious or atheists. In case of Christians there is no necessity for both the parties should be a Christians. Even one of the party from other religion can perform a marriage with a Christian under Indian Christian marriage act without changing or converting his or her religion to Christianity.

The Indian Divorce Act provides if a Christian who is converted to other religion is entitled for the other spouse to divorce his or her spouse. There is no clear picture in the divorce law governed for Christians that the non-Christian partner can divorce his or her spouse for the change of religion of a Christian spouse. In Islam any one party who converts to another religion can divorce the opponent spouse. The Special marriage act provides a party belong to same religion or different religion can marry under the civil rights and obligations between them. The person who married under the Special Marriage Act has no provision for divorce when the other spouse has converted his or her religion.

No legislation has declared what is conversion of religion. The law says merely attending other religious activities or practising the religious things is not conversion of religion. What is the actual conversion of religion? In gazette offices where a converted person seeks to publish that he or she is converted to other religion has certain yard stick for conversion. A mere baptism is not a conversion of a Hindu or an Islam to Christian Religion, they must produce conversion certificate from the Church office. A person cannot become a Hindu from other religion by performing certain poojas for conversion, but a certificate from Arya Samaj is a valid form of conversion from other religion to Hinduism. These are the conversion methods following in India despite of the other recognised form of conversion.

TECHNOLOGY OF 3D PRINTING

The Technology of 3D printing for prosperous packaging - beyond prototyping

3D Printing is a digital manufacturing technology that engages a range of processes and applications, with a common premise of additive technology. The Additive technology is the process of making 3 Dimensional solid objects that builds the parts up, usually layer-upon-layer either by Fused Deposition (FDM) or with Laser Sintering (SLS) technology. 3 D Printing enables to produce complex (functional shapes using less material than traditional manufacturing methods. This additive approach ultimately enables manufacturers to eliminate the need for tooling.

3D printing has already had a big impact on the packaging industry. The possibilities of 3D printing have expanded in the packaging industry in latest years beyond prototyping. There has been a lot of interest and research in 3D printing that elevated the packaging industry to the next height. The pharmaceutical companies use their 3D printers to construct functional prototypes for their drug packaging (Primary and Secondary).

Revolutionizing Packaging Machinery

3D printing will also impact packaging machinery manufacturers. For example, 3D printing can be used for printing robotic arms used in production. Therefore, 3D printing is anticipated to positively impact packaging machinery manufacturers.

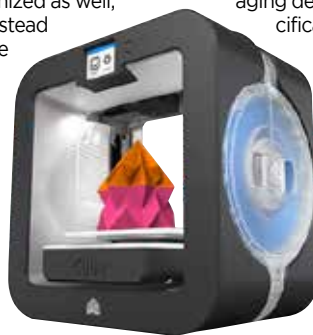
