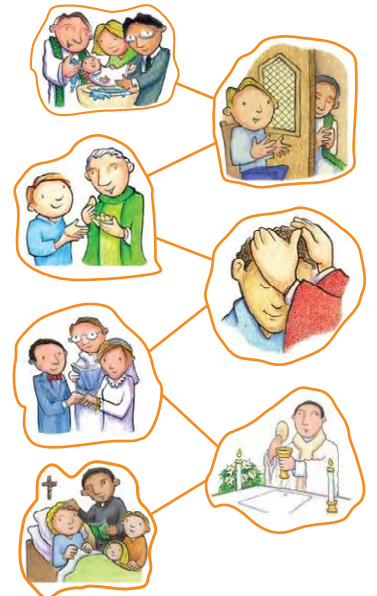

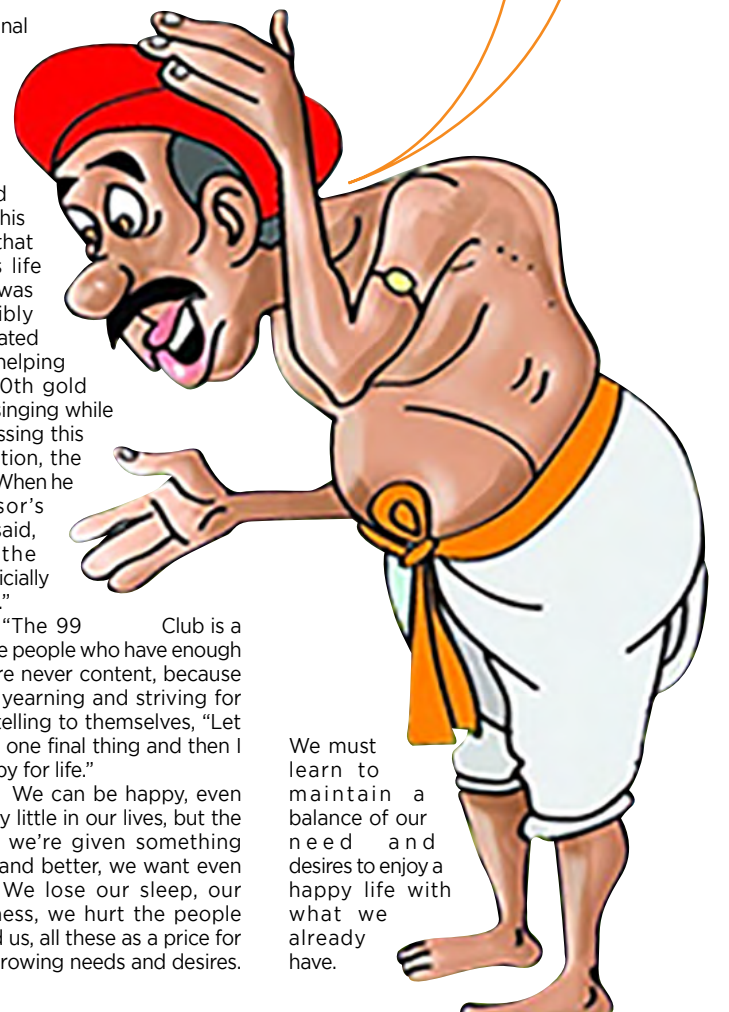
He looked everywhere

tempting to the human eye - can have its consequences on who we truly are. Everyone has desire. We cannot find a single person without this feeling. This feeling can be both positive as well as negative. Positive desire (feeling) leads an individual towards some achievement. Negative desire (feeling) leads to something unwanted. At the outset, we must clarify the meaning of desire. Desire has to be defined as something that impels an individual towards something to aspire or to attain. He said, "I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed: 'We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal.'" This is the desire and dream of Martin Luther and he was able to achieve this in America.

identity. Finding a job for living is not wrong but this is desired. Nevertheless, everyone must ask a question: Does my living affect the society and how does?

There are people who desire for something to the world. For instance, the works of the social activists have been for the good of the nation or a community. Their desire is oriented towards their community or nation. The protest of the farmers in India is of this type. The farmers are not worried about the loss of their income for a certain period and they are fighting for all farmers of India. The service of the late Fr. Stan Swamy for the tribal people of Jharkand is of this type of desire. He never lived for himself but for the community. Meet **Tushar Kanjilal**, a man who is commonly known as the Saviour of the Sundarbans is working for 50 years to make the Sundarbans alive. Though he has been awarded with several awards, even with the highest of India's, yet he proposes his apprehension that if the next generation will turn towards saving the ecology. Does the younger generation have interest in common issues or satisfied with themselves?

Now, a question arises inherently: Is it possible

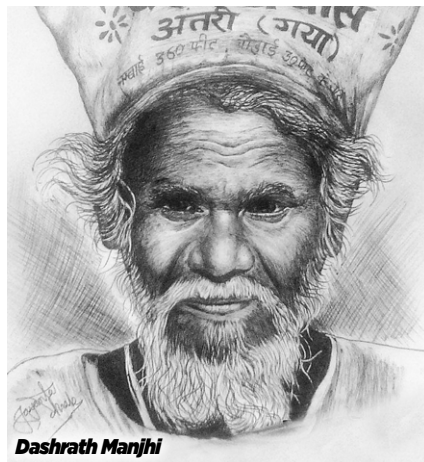

Once, the path is set, the journey becomes easy.

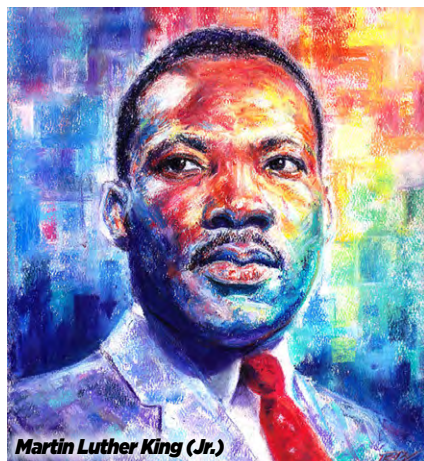
Secondly, we must show the budding minds to find out the hurdles of desire that hinders them

feel a great kick. Something is going to happen; you are on the verge of it. And then you have the car, you have the yacht, you have the house, and suddenly all is meaningless again.

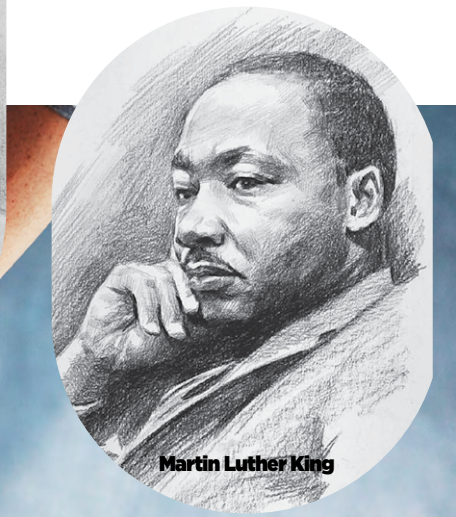
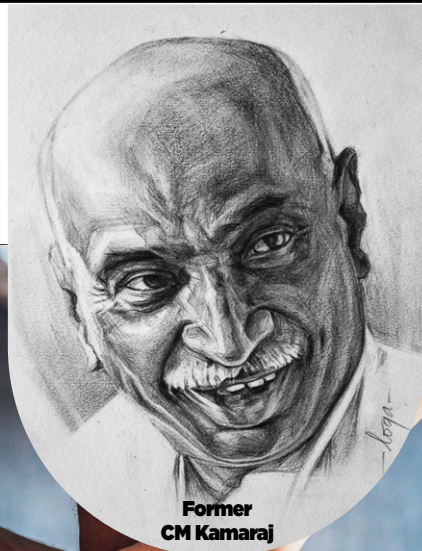

**country where racism was ruled out and children of all races were playing together... that was his desire.**

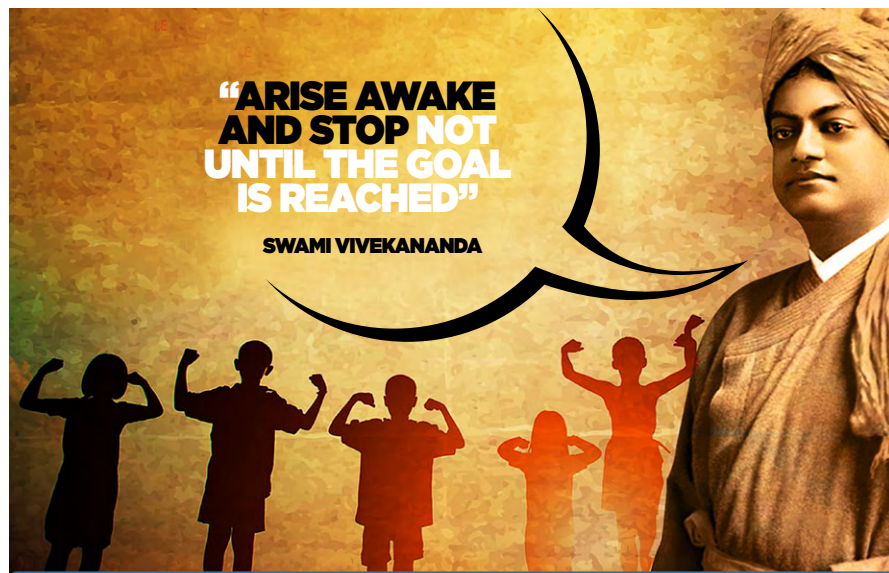

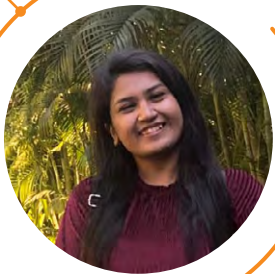

We are all definitely aware of the ongoing and ever-lasting concepts of yin and yang, karma and balanced dualism. It is only sensible that dark co-exists with brightness. Through religious practices, dharma and simple prayers, we try to gather this good energy for various reasons.

With these concepts, many social netizens have picked up the trend of manifestation and tarot reading in recent months. What started as a Tik Tok trend video became so viral that Tarot reading, Vaastu experts and manifestation mentors are at their peak times in the 'gram. Although these spiritual channelling of inner and outer energies have been prevalent, it is still a question as to how the millennials and Gen Z are giving life to these.

Every human being is entitled to have various worldly or imaginary desires in his life. Not one, not two but definitely as many as he/she could wish to. Would you believe if someone said you can turn your desires into your reality without sweating a bead?

Here I introduce to you, the concept of manifestation and the steps to achieve your desires. One can term this as a derived practice from the 'Law of Attraction. To

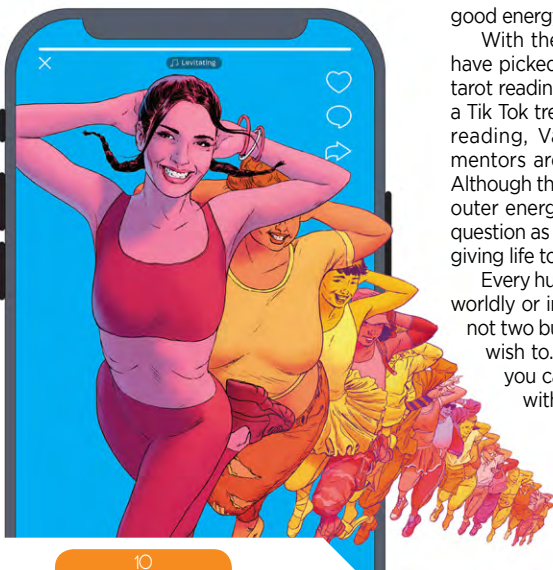

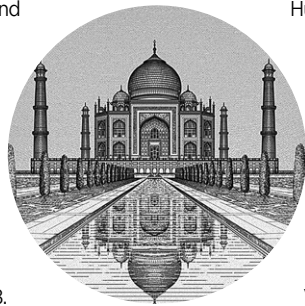
Barnes' desire was not a hope! It was not a wish! It was keen, pulsating DESIRE, which

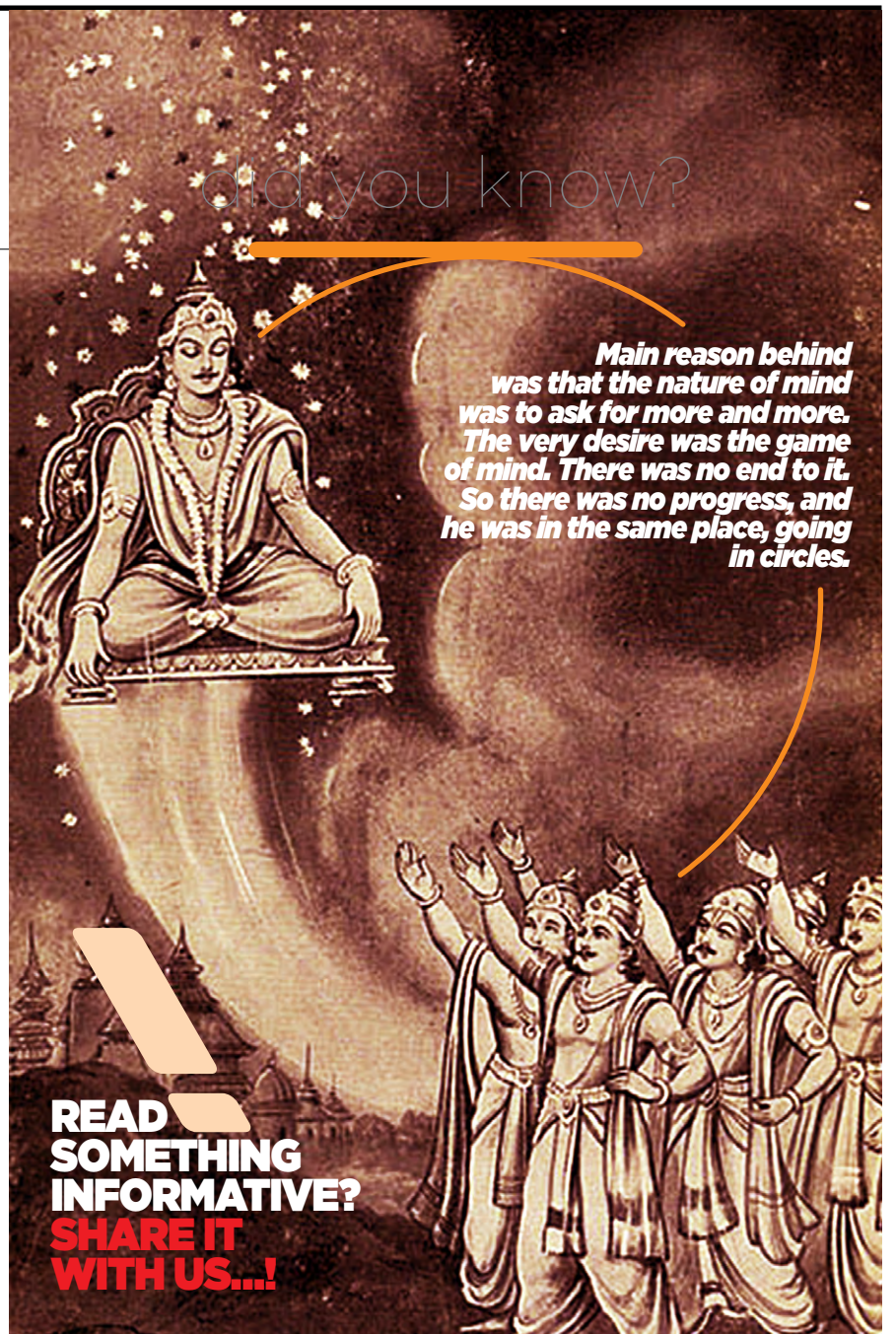
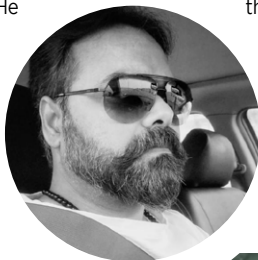

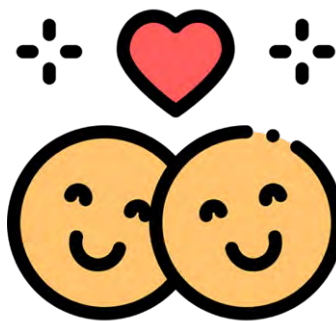


#### WEALTH

That's really about it. I only want 6 things in life, it turns out. And it can be argued that I've already got most of them in one form or another.

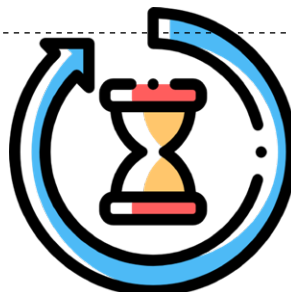

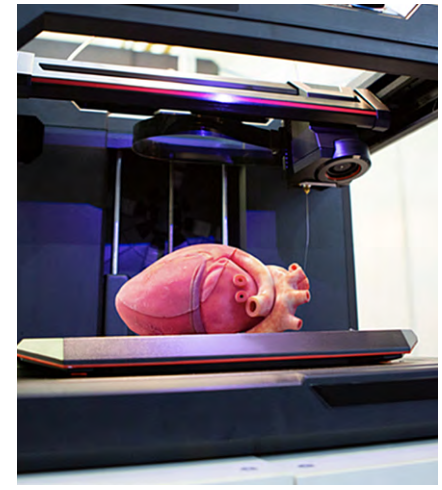

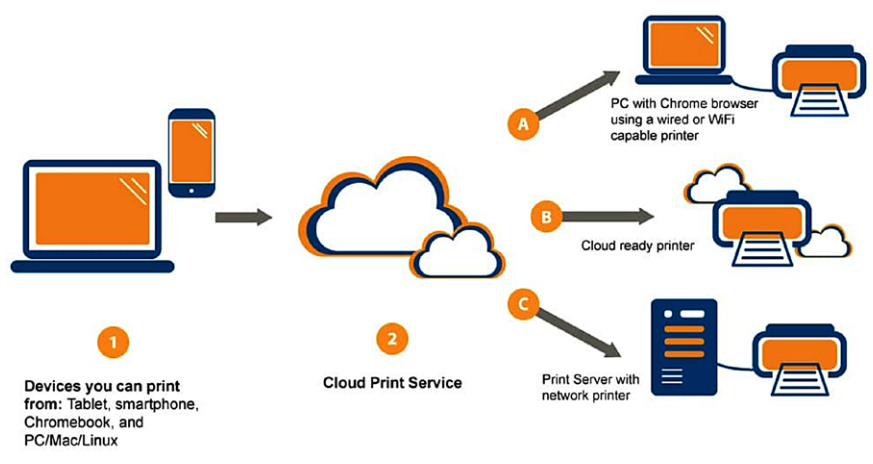
