

which we think we ought to win over others, but in reality, only lead losing ourselves





This woman with a warm beetle-stained smile, clad in a rustic colour of green and red named Sakthi welcomed me. During the course of our conversation, little did I know I would learn about the arduous journey of this 55-year-old who conceals her woes and worries underneath her chirpy appearance.

Hailing from a village in Theni, Tamil Nadu,

Hailing from a village in Theni, Tamil Nadu, Sakthi tells her tale of hard work and growing into the woman she has become today. "I came to Chennai with my two children at the age of 22. I drove this very fruit stall tirelessly and worked like a man, despite my ill health to take care of my family". She continues talking about her journey from being just a small-town girl to a strong mother of two.

"Now, I live happily with my children and my grandchildren. They take care of me and although we do face financial troubles, we live a content and proud life without being in debt," Sakthi says as tears of pride and joy run down her aged-cheek.

Sakthi firmly believes that the trees that are near her stall – Neem and Banyan stands tall to protect her livelihood from troubles. She even credited the long-standing oak for being the reason her and her family did not contract the COVID-19.

"Chennai may be just a place to the residents here but as someone who left behind everything to settle down, I have an irresistible compassion towards the people here. The sun shines bright and the rains are harsh, just like people but again that is the beauty of the city here," she added. Sakthi also believes that her devotion to Lord Shiva in turn brings blessing to her family through the winds that flows along the neem tree.

Watching Sakthi talk about how that she loves and cares for the tree, just as much as she loves her children and other such little joys in her life was the most heart-warming sight for sore eyes. Her perspective on life in the post-COVID era is contrary to the common perception of people from lower socio-economic backgrounds. "I struggled hard to make my ends

meet since March 2020 but there was one thought that kept me going amidst the chaos -I have no right to cry over not making money, when people are suffering with the dreadful virus every single day. I count my blessings, every night before I shut my eyes and pray that the Lord ends the miseries of those in deeper troubles than my own," she added.

The compassion and gratitude for life that Sakthi carried nearly moved me to tears. "I have never wanted money or property. What is the point of wanting to earn millions and millions? At the end, what remains is how happy you have lived your life. Education, love and knowledge are the true wealth one can possess", she says. One can find the adoration and deep affection of Sakthi for her grandson Mani, who rides away on his bicycle to school.

Cortisol. The goodness and evil travels inside the human body and the feelings of the humans decide the secretion of love and hate.


